

Visitors occupying the DWYC Guest Dock must follow all Dana Point Marina Rules

- **Pets are not permitted** on guest boats or on the dock.
 - **Disturbing noises are not permitted between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m.**
 - Except when entering or leaving the Slip, unnecessary operation of engines, generators and other noise-making machinery is prohibited.
 - Halyards shall be tied off to eliminate noise.
 - Guests, their family and visitors shall not engage in any conduct which will interfere with the rights, comforts or convenience of others.
 - Children under 12 years are not permitted on docks without the immediate presence of their parents or other responsible adults. Non-swimmers and toddlers are requested to wear life jackets when on the docks.
 - **Water Conservation:** Automatic shut-off nozzles must be attached to hoses.
 - **Electrical Connections:** In accordance with the Orange County Fire Code No. 419, all connections made to the Marina receptacles shall be grounded and U.L. approved. Wiring must be of adequate size for the power provided. Electrical shore-power connections must be marine grade and be in good, safe condition.
 - **Dock Key(s):** There is a \$100.00 fee for lost each dock key lost or not returned.
 - **Arrival & Departure Times:** Unless otherwise specified, guest boats shall not arrive before 12:00 Noon of the arrival date, and must disembark before 12:00 noon on the departure date
